It is a watershed moment in Canadian history! On October 30, 1995, the Quebec referendum was a highly contested and emotionally charged debate for the “yes” and “no” sides. And what was the rest of Canada doing? Some wrote letters to show support. Our play is set on this intense and dramatic evening. Newcomers from the war-torn Yugoslavia draw a Canadian concert cellist into their own crisis of identity.

The one week run is the first public presentation of this original work by playwright **Douglas Campbell**; sound scape and music by musician/composer **Nick Storing**.
